IMPACT OF THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC ON THE MENTAL HEALTH OUTCOME OF PATIENTS WITH PRE-EXISTING MENTAL DISORDERS: PRELIMINARY RESULTS FROM THE BASELINE SURVEY AT THE INAD-PSMAR

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Background

The covid-19 pandemic may impact negatively on mental health of vulnerable populations, including people with mental illness. This study analyzed the mental health status in a sample of patients from the INAD-PSMAR during the COVID-19 outbreak.

Method

This is a survey-based study collecting clinical data from patients with mental disorders. The study was conducted from 06/05/2020 to 09/06/2020. We measured the social support using the 3-items OSSS. The magnitude of depression and anxiety symptoms were assessed by the Spanish versions of the PHQ-8 and the 7-item GAD scale, respectively. Suicidal thoughts and behaviors were evaluated with a modified version of the C-SSRS. A descriptive analysis was performed using IBM SPSS Statistics program, v. 20.

Results

951 adult patients (mean (SD) age, 47.42 (12.30) years) were included in the analysis. Sample characteristics are detailed in Table 1. A total of 336 respondents (35.3%) endorsed depression (PHQ-8 > 15); and 269 (28.3%) anxiety (GAD-7 > 14). In relation to suicidal risk, 378 individuals reported death wishes (39.7%); 201, ideation (21.1%); 201, plans (21.1%); and 21, an attempt (2.2%) during the last month. Low rates of social support (OSSS-3 < 8) were reported by 324 (34.1%) respondents.

Conclusions

The preliminary results of this survey suggest that early stages of wave 1 of the COVID-19 pandemic are associated with high levels of depression, anxiety and suicidal ideation on patients with preexisting mental disorders. Understanding the long-term consequences of pandemic among this vulnerable population is essential for improving mental health policy in Spain.
